Dear Parent/Guardian:

Zion Elementary District 6 is committed to providing a high-quality education for your child. We are working hard to provide programs to help our students succeed in our school district. All students are screened three times a year to ensure that they are able to meet grade level/state standards for learning. Students that fall below this standard are referred for intervention services in the areas needed. Further, the district and the State Board of Education are working with your child's school to help improve the academic standards of the school. This is being accomplished by providing technical assistance to the teachers and administrators within your child's school. We need your assistance at home as well. This includes developing and maintaining a study time for your child at home, following up with all school assignments, and active participation in the parent organization as well as school-based programs and events.

Your child attends East Elementary School which receives federal Title I funds. These funds provide help for your child to meet state achievement standards. Student achievement results at East Elementary School were excellent for the 2011-12 school year, and as a result, the school met its Annual Yearly Progress goals. However, because East did not meet the annual goals in the two previous years, the school remains in Federal school improvement status. This means that your child is eligible for public school services and supplemental educational services. (A family must meet low-income guidelines to qualify for Supplemental Education Services).

Our district's 2012 report card and the most recent AYP status report for your school show how your child's school compares to other schools in our district and state. These reports will be available on our Web site, at your child's school, and at the school district office as soon as they are available from the State.

You may make a decision about your option for public school choice by choosing one of the following for your child.

- Remain at East Elementary School. The school met its yearly goals for the 2011-2012 and will continue to implement strong improvement plans to ensure success for students.
- Transfer to a qualifying elementary school within the district: Beulah Park. Transportation will be
 provided by the district if the new school is <u>more than 1.5 miles</u> from your home. If demand for
 transportation exceeds funds available, priority will be given to the lowest-achieving students from
 low-income families. Title I services are also provided at these schools as well.

To apply for transfer your child to one of the schools listed above, you must complete the Student Transfer Form enclosed and return it to the District 6 curriculum office during the enrollment period. *This will be your only enrollment opportunity for the upcoming 2012-13 school year.* If you have questions or need assistance with this application, please contact Dr. Kris Raitzer, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction at Zion School District #6. Thank you for your continued interest in your child's education.
